Although the COVID Health Pandemic came to an "official end" on May 11, 2023, cases have been reported to our health offices already. We ask you to exercise diligence at home should your child/children become sick. Please **do not send sick children to school**. Kindly follow any COVID symptoms with a call to your health care provider.



We will begin student lunch service for grades 6-12 on Friday, September 8, and for elementary students on Monday. September 18. Payments for lunch will be made through <a href="PaySchoolsCentral">PaySchoolsCentral</a>. Please be sure to complete the lunch <a href="applications for the free and reduced lunch">applications for the free and reduced lunch program. All students eligible for reduced lunch will receive FREE lunch again this year.



Individual Student Score Reports for 22-23 NJSLA assessments in grades 3-10 ELA and in grades 3-8 mathematics, Alg I and Geometry will be sent home to parents as soon as the District receives them. We have posted the <u>assessment schedule for the 23-24</u> school year on our curriculum page. Updates to <u>NJ Graduation requirements</u> (from May 2023) can be found on the NJDOE website.



Technology is available to all of our students as part of our one-to-one initiative. Students may not use their own devices for instructional purposes when in school. New devices will be distributed to students in grades 1, 5 and 9. Insurance is available for purchase to protect devices from damage. Although this is a voluntary program, enrollment is highly recommended for substantial savings and reduced costs associated with damaged Chromebooks.
